Objectives-

1. To understand what academic writing means and the activities involved.
2. To identify the writing issues, you face and learn how to manage/knock out Writer's Block.
3. To understand the importance of building and expanding vocabulary in order to communicate your ideas in a clear and effective manner
4. To examine the importance of understanding 'rhetoric' and become familiar with the basic types of academic writing or modes.
5. To revise and practice the basic writing process [pre-writing, writing, and re-writing] using in-class activities [or homework?]
6. To learn the importance of Intellectual property in order to avoid plagiarism.
7. To identify the writing issues participants face at this point in their studies.
8. To revise what academic writing means and the activities involved in the process.
