Objectives-

- 1. To be able to differentiate the writing processes and strategies for audience, purpose, and type of task(assignment, op-ed, research paper etc.) (Level III)
- 2. To be able to demonstrate and apply knowledge of basic essay structure, including
- 3. introduction, body and conclusion (Level III)
- 4. To be able to demonstrate understanding of and apply the principles of effective paragraph structure; write concise sentences; employ quotation, paraphrase and summary. (Level III)
- 5. To be able to effectively make use of such surface features as syntax, grammar, punctuation, and spelling. (Level III)
- 6. To be able to utilize descriptive, narrative and expository modes(Level III)
- 7. To be able to develop a cogent claim in writing and defend it with appropriate proofs (Level III)
- 8. To be able to construct ethical and unbiased argumentation (Level III)
