Brief Overview:

Symbiosis School of International Studies organized a 5-day FDP from 3rd - 7th Oct 2023, in collaboration with STLRC (SIU) and Monk Prayogshala, Mumbai. The objective of the proposed FDP was to sensitize faculty members to qualitative research methods and software tools available for data analysis that find application in research related to international relations, such as NVIVO or ATLAS.ti. It aims to build the capacity of qualitative researchers in qualitative data management and analysis.

Learning Outcomes: By the end of the FDP, participants will be able to:

- i. Understand qualitative analysis approaches
- ii. Understand different qualitative data collection methods
- iii. Understand ways to interpret qualitative data
- iv. Learn software for qualitative data analysis (such as NVIVO, ATLAS.ti)
- v. Recognize the field implementation of qualitative research
- vi. Write qualitative grant proposals
- vii. Appraise the quality of qualitative research methods
- viii. Apply the learnings through structured assignments
